Steamtown Marathon - Volunteer Job Descriptions

SATURDAY

RACE EXPO (8:00AM to 5:00PM, Scranton High School) - Welcome the athletes at the Expo, give them their number, packet and race shirt.

FINISH LINE SET UP – (8:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Courthouse Square) - Help to construct and prepare the finish line area in downtown Scranton.

RACE DAY OPPORTUNITIES

FINISH AREA COURTHOUSE SQUARE, DURING RACE – (9:30 AM to 2:30 PM) - Provide runners with food, fluids, medals, blankets, information and directions to baggage area, family meeting areas, etc. Security volunteers will be responsible for the keeping the flow of people moving in the proper direction, as well as keeping unauthorized people out of the finish area. Note - Be prepared for a long day!

FINISH AREA, RUNNER ASSISTANCE (9:30 AM to 2:30 PM)– Runner massage, medical care (appropriate experience, training and background required)

RACE COURSE - (8:00AM to 2:00PM) - Hand out fluids to runners, traffic control, course security, traffic cones, video monitoring, record bib numbers of lead runners, etc...

FINISH AREA AFTER RACE – (2:00 PM to 5:00 PM) - Break down chute, signage, scaffolding, general cleanup, etc...
